The National Championship Regatta shall be conducted in accordance with the sailing instructions, this Notice of Race, the Catalina 27 Class Rules and Bylaws of the International Catalina 27/270 Association, and the 2009 – 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing of the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) with US Sailing prescriptions (<http://www.ussailing.com/rules/>), in that order of preference.

Eligibility:

Open to any Catalina 27 yacht which conforms to all specifications and holds a valid measurement certificate as set forth in the IC27/270A bylaws, and whose Skipper/Owner is a member in good standing of the International Catalina 27/270 Association as well as a local IC27/270A fleet (if one is available in your area).

Fleets:

Gold Fleet (Spinnaker Class) No rating penalty will be applied to any yachts in this fleet.

Open to standard rig Catalina 27 yachts only. Max head sail is 170%.

Silver Fleet (Non-Spinnaker Class), jib and main only. Max headsail is 170%. Use of double headsails will not be allowed. Open to all Catalina 27 and Catalina 270 yachts. Yachts, rigs, inboards, outboards and 170% genoas will be handicapped per Chesapeake Bay PHRF ratings.

There will be a combined, single start for the Gold and Silver Fleets.

All yachts needing to be measured must report to the Annapolis Maryland Capitol Yacht Club (AMCYC) ready for measurement unless measurement of selected items is waived. Fees:
